3. If the behavior occurs again after step two, the student will be referred to the Vice Principal, who will take over the discipline process

Grades:

The grades for 7th grade reading are calculated as follows:

- 30% of the student's grade will be based on formative work (daily assignments such as group work, quizzes, etc.)
- 70% of the student's grade will be based on summative assessments (tests).
