Northwest Oklahoma DAV 2020 Scholarship Application

DEFINITION:

1. Cash award for one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be a
 - a. Veteran, active duty member, or dependent (spouse or child as defined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs) residing or attending school in northwest Oklahoma (Alfalfa, Beaver, Blaine, Cimarron, Dewey, Ellis, Garfield, Grant, Harper, Kay, Kingfisher, Logan, Major, Noble, Payne, Texas, Woods, and Woodward counties) or a
 - b. Graduating high school senior with a full academic year of Junior ROTC while attending school in northwest Oklahoma (Alfalfa, Beaver, Blaine, Cimarron, Dewey, Ellis, Garfield, Grant, Harper, Kay, Kingfisher, Logan, Major, Noble, Payne, Texas, Woods, and Woodward counties) or a
 - c. Spouse, child, or grandchild of a Full-life paid member of Northwest Oklahoma DAV Chapter 66.
2. Applicant must have a High School diploma, General Educational Development (GED) certificate, or be a graduating high school senior. If applicant is none of these, a detailed explanation of their plans and goals must be submitted.
3. Applicant must show proof of acceptance, or intent to apply, to a specific program (degree, certificate, etc.) at an accredited college, technology center, or training institution.
4. Enrollment must be for at least one-half time for each enrollment session. Enrollment may include remedial, refresher and deficiency type course work.
5. Prerequisite course work, training experiences, and regular course work must be towards a specific degree or program.
6. Dropped course work or complete withdrawal from session will require reimbursement of scholarship funds unless acceptable mitigating reasons are given in writing to the NWOKDAV Scholarship Committee.
7. Grade point average must be equivalent to a "C" or higher average.
8. Other tuition/fees, waiver funds, or other scholarships will not disqualify the recipient from this scholarship.
9. Recipient may apply for this scholarship for multiple years. However, reapplication is not a guarantee that a past year recipient would be selected.

SCHOLARSHIP USES & DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS:

1. Recipient will be awarded a one-time payment before September of the year of entrance in a qualified program.
2. Award can be used for student fees, P.E. fees, lab fees, music fees, books, materials, supplies, equipment, or necessary uniforms.
3. Award can be used for all time periods - semesters, trimesters, training time period, etc.

APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT:

1. Completed scholarship application form. (A digital application form is available upon request.)
2. Proof of qualifying veteran status (Copy of DD-214, DoD or VA ID card, or other documents)
3. Proof of dependent status.
4. Copy of latest school transcript
5. Copy of School program acceptance letter, when received
6. Letters of recommendation (at least three; may not be from a relative)
 - a. One must be from your school counselor
 - b. One must be from someone other than a school employee
 - c. Letters must include signatory's name and phone number.

The scholarship selection committee may conduct a candidate interview in person, by video chat, or by phone.
