

# AP literature Lesson Plans

April 20-24, 2020

This week we will continue to prepare for the AP literature exam and work on our writing skills (for those who aren't taking the test). On Thursday you will get another question 2 with one day to prepare and one day to write (next week it will all be done in one day). The sentence practice on Wednesday is a great little exercise to work on the complexity of your writing.

Monday, April 20, 2020

-read "A Worn Path" by Eudora Welty

\*what are two different themes presented in "A Worn Path"

Tuesday, April 21, 2020

-discuss the way the characterization of Phoenix contributes to a theme in "A Worn Path"

\*write a quality paragraph of at least 200 words

Wednesday, April 22, 2020

-sentence practice

>write an informative paragraph over a topic of your choice

>5 sentences (1 = topic sentence [short sentence], 2, 3 & 4 = body sentences [longer sentences - at least 40 words each with compound and complex structures], and 5 = concluding sentence [shorter sentence])

\*you may write more if you choose - this is just a pattern for practice

\*make the conscious effort to write longer body sentences that develop layers of meaning

Thursday, April 23, 2020

-AP literature question 2

>develop a defensible claim and outline to write

\*the defensible claim is paramount for those of you who are going to take the AP literature exam

\*the question will be found on google classroom

Friday, April 24, 2020

-AP literature question 2

>put 45 minutes on the clock and write your paper

\*take 25-30 minutes to write and 5-10 minutes for revising and editing
