This first 3 days of this week will involve a timed writing. You will only be able to access the prompt on google classroom because I cannot share the prompt in an open forum. If you cannot access google classroom, shoot me an email from your phone, and I will find a way to get it to you. We will be breaking this into three parts just to walk through the process (and this is for any writing assignment you will get in college).

Monday, April 13, 2020

-break down the prompt

>if you are taking the AP exam in May, you will get question 2 (this is what it will look like)
>read the prompt and annotate the passage (I would encourage you to make a copy of the passage and mark it up)

Tuesday, April 14, 2020

-write your thesis statement and create an outline

>thesis statement must make a defensible claim

>outline how you will prove your claim

>decide what specific references from the text that you will use to defend your points

Wednesday, April 15, 2020

-write your essay

>put 40 minutes on the clock and write

>shoot for at least 600 words

>save a few minutes to revise and edit

Thursday, April 16, 2020

-read "Once Upon a Time" by Nadine Gordimer (it has a slightly, okay not so slightly, dark twist to the fairy tale thing)
