## SPEECH & LANGUAGE HOMEWORK: BUBBLES


This activity focuses on the following speech and language skills: joint attention, requesting more, using the b, m, g, p, w sounds, following routine, imitating words and sounds.

Materials: Bottle of bubbles with wand Directions:

- 1. Show your child the bottle of bubbles.

  Practice saying or signing "open" and "bubble".

  Encourage your child to imitate your words.
- Once you have the bubbles open, dip the stick into the solution and hold it up. Say "Ready, Set, Go!" After practicing a few times, pause before "go" and encourage your child to say "go!".
- 3. Blow bubbles. Say "wow" as they fall.
- 4. When bubbles land start popping them and say "pop!" each time.
- 5. Before the next round of bubbles ask "more?" Encourage your child to say or sign "more".
- 6. Repeat steps 2-5.



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
