Dear Seniors and Parents,

Graduation is quickly approaching, May 20, 2022 at 7:30 pm, and we need to remind you of several items. Graduation from high school marks an important milestone in the lives of our students. Therefore, it is important that they realize the solemnity of this occasion. With this in mind, please discuss the following with your student(s):

- 1. Dress code Senior boys need to wear dark pants, dark shoes, and a white collared shirt. Ties are recommended but not required. Girls need to wear dresses, skirts/pants with a nice blouse. Jewelry should not be worn outside the graduation gown nor clothing beyond academic recognition. Nothing except the tassel should be on the mortarboard (cap). Anything that distracts or draws undue attention should be avoided. Students who do not adhere to this dress code may not be allowed to walk.
- 2. Behavior the students' behavior at graduation speaks volumes about their school, their families, and the students themselves. Anything that disrupts the services will not be allowed. That includes, but is not limited to, Silly String, "poppers," air horns, masking tape messages on mortar boards (caps), moving chairs, etc. We ask that our seniors behave in a way appropriate to this occasion.
- 3. Photographs a professional photographer will be taking pictures of your students after they receive their diploma. Information will then be mailed/emailed to your home address.
- 4. Out of respect for the graduates and families, we ask that you remain seated until the ceremony is completed. Once commencement exercises have ended, guests may meet their graduate(s) on the floor of the arena for pictures and a time of celebration., you may meet them on Harrison Street directly north of the construction zone in the city owned parking area.

Please sign, date, and return the attached agreement to the GHS Main Office before 3:00 p.m. on May 18, 2022. <u>Students who do not return the agreement may not be allowed to take part in graduation ceremonies.</u>
