1. Why do you want to attend Meridian Tech?
2. If one of your Faver / BJA teacher advisers were to write you a letter of recommendation, what would that person say?
3. How much of your assigned work do you complete on time?
4. What do you think you must improve upon to be ready to do well at Meridian Tech?
5. Tell me one thing about yourself that would support your application to Meridian Tech?
6. Tell me about yourself.
7. The training at MTC is valued at approximately \$60,000. What is your plan for the future to utilize your training & certifications?

Typical High School Interview Questions (www.study.com)

Each interviewer will have a unique set of questions but, at many schools, you may expect to be asked some variation of the 10 questions listed below:

- What are your weaknesses?
- What subject do you enjoy most? Why?
- What subject do you like least? Why?
- How do you like to spend your free time?
- If I asked your friends to describe you, what would they say?
- What have you read recently?
- What has been your biggest challenge?
- What is your definition of a good teacher?
- What would you like to accomplish, academically or in extracurricular activities, at GHS & MTC?
- Why did you decide to apply to MTC?

Practice your answers with family or friends before your interview. This can help minimize the amount of anxiety you might feel about the interview.

Technically, not every item is a question. Some are statements that prompt you for a response.

Good interview questions are open-ended; they can't be answered with a "yes" or "no." They invite thoughtful response. Even if you are asked a question that can be answered with a "yes" or "no," (e.g. "Are you comfortable with the amount of travel this job involves?"), you can add explanation to back up your answer (e.g., "Yes. I actually look forward to the opportunity to travel and to work with the staff members in some of the other offices.")
